- Camping/amenities/access: This is a primitive camping area. No hookups. Restrooms (4 portable outhouses) will be provided. There is no drinking water, please bring your own 5-gallon jugs, or fill up at the City Park in Ukiah (Main & Camas), there will be a marked spigot there. There is also an RV Dumping Station at the City Park in Ukiah. Water for goats can be obtained from the Twin Ponds. This is a large flat open area with lots of pine trees and camping sites. Access is good for cars, trailers and RVs (gravel road). There is plenty of goat browse. Certified weed free hay is required. Please do not non-weed free hay to this location. is also available, Notify Curtis King, by June 17th if you need hay (\$13.00 a bale.) curtis.king66@yahoo.com 1-509-539-0982. Firewood will be provided at the central fire pit area. PLEASE LEAVE YOUR CAMPSITE CLEANER THAN YOU FOUND IT. Do not leave food or trash outside.
- Typical Weather: daytime highs in the mid-high 70s, nighttime lows in the 30s.

- Cell phone service: (ATT and Verizon) available in Ukiah, spotty elsewhere. Land-line phone at Rhodes Supply, also at the Stage Stop & the Thicket Tavern for emergency calls.
- Nearby Amenities: Rhodes Supply in Ukiah (7.5 miles) 202 W Main Street, 541-427-3271 lce, Propane, and small grocery items. ICE CREAM! Ukiah City Park, (corner Main Street and Camas) has an RV dump and water supply located on the south east corner of the park. \$5.00 for RV Dump. The park has a great fresh water faucet from the ground well. Make sure you use the right faucet. The signs are on the fence. Water is free. Fill up your five gallon jugs with fresh drinking water before you drive out to the twin ponds camp.
